Our Sages tell us that Asher, the son of our forefather Yaakov, sits at the opening of Gehinnom and saves any soul on whose behalf Mishnah is being studied. This idea is derived from the *passuk* in Bereishis (49:20) in which the *shevet* (tribe) of Asher is described: "From Asher, his bread is fat (שמן)." The word שמן contains the same letters as Mishnah (משנה) and as *neshamah* (נשמה), the Hebrew word for soul; this alludes to the fact that Mishnah is what sustains the soul in the world to come and that Asher saves neshamos from Gehinnom in the merit of Mishnah study. In fact, Mishnah study can achieve more for the soul of the departed than can leading the congregation in prayer (*P'nei Boruch 39:13, note 25*).

Studying Mishnah as a merit for the *neshamah* of the deceased during the first year after passing can save it from the punishment of reincarnation (*L'olam Hevei Ratz L'Mishnah - introductory notes to some Mishnah editions*).

Chevrah Lomdei Mishnah and the **National Association of Chevra Kadisha (NASCK)** provide this user-friendly Mishnah chart to supply mourners with a practical format to facilitate Mishnah study for the merit of their loved one.



Chevrah Lomdei Mishnah also provides Mishnah study services on behalf of mourners or family members who may not have the training or time to study Mishnah for the merit of their departed loved one. Torah scholars can be commissioned to complete the entire Shishah Sidrei Mishnah or one or more *masechtos* of *mishnayos* for the *shloshim* or *yahrtzeit*. *Masechtos* of Gemara can be completed as well.
